There are 3 options for the applique blocks

#### Fusible Appliqué - Machine

.5 metre "steam a seam" (paper backed fusible web)
Thread for machine stitching

<u>OR</u>

## Fusible Appliqué - Hand

.5 metre "steam a seam" (paper backed fusible web) DMC thread for hand stitching.

<u>OR</u>

## Needle turn Appliqué - Hand

.2 freezer paper.

Silk thread or thread to match the appliqué.

Pins.

Template plastic or Cardboard.
