## **Note**

The needs list has been broken into colours to allow for a scrappy look and to allow you to delve into your stash. You can choose to use one fabric for all the appliqués and one colour for the pieced blocks. **Or** for an easier option you could use a jelly roll for your pieced blocks and choose a matching fabric for the appliqué blocks.

You do not need all of the listed fabrics for the class, just enough to get you started.

## **Equipment**

Sewing machine

Rulers – 7" square (I will have some available for use in class)

Favourite ruler for cutting strips

Thread for piecing



There are 3 options for the applique blocks

**Fusible Appliqué - Machine**

.5 metre "steam a seam" (paper backed fusible web)

Thread for machine stitching

**OR**

**Fusible Appliqué - Hand**

.5 metre "steam a seam" (paper backed fusible web)

DMC thread for hand stitching.

**OR**

**Needle turn Appliqué - Hand**

.2 freezer paper.

Silk thread or thread to match the appliqué.

Pins.

Template plastic or Cardboard.
